HELPFUL COMMENTS FOR EACH VENUE:

Please see the MVA Rules and study the ones for the venues you are entering.
Neutered and spayed dogs are allowed to compete for MVA!

Important for all venues

- Move-Ups: Typically move-ups are at the discretion of the hosting club.
- For MVA move-ups will NOT be allowed.
Example: Herding – Competitor qualifies in a herding run and completes title for that level.
The participant has the option to stay at the current level and attempt to earn a higher score in the trial OR they may choose to move up to the next level to work on the next level title.
If they move up to the higher lever, that score is NOT allowed for their base MVA points in Herding.
If they qualify at the higher level they are entitled to the 10 point bonus for an additional qualifying run.

Herding:

- You must enter a herding level in order to be considered for MVA.
- Levels are Herding Instinct, HCC, Junior, Started, Open and Advanced
- The Herding Instinct test (HIC) is the basic test and even if you already have a HIC certificate you must enter HIC at Nationals if you are not going to enter the higher levels.
- You must enter the level you have titled in or have earned a leg in. If you have earned a leg in a higher level than your current title you must enter that higher level.

NADAC Agility:

- We are running under NADAC Rules, they are the Host club for our Nationals.
- Please read all the rules for NADAC on their website.
- Enter ONLINE only thru NADAC.
- You must also pre-register your dog with NADAC before competing.
- Dogs must be 18 months or older to compete

APDT Rally:

- You must pre register your dog thru APDT Rally before competing.
- Please read all the APDT Rally rules on their website.
- You must chose which level you are competing at for MVA points.

Disc Dog:

- There will be two rounds of Toss and Catch and one round of freestyle.
- You must enter Toss and Catch, the freestyle is for an additional 10 points, if you have a qualifying round in Toss and Catch.
- Qualifying means your dog has earned a minimum of 6 pts in one of the rounds.
