Directions: K9 Manners & More training center is at 1000 E Memphis, Broken Arrow, OK 74012.

This is on the northeast corner of Lynn Lane & Memphis. From the Broken Arrow Expressway (highway 51) take the Lynn Lane exit and go south 2 miles. Cross the railroad tracks just south of 81st street and turn left.

FYI: Lynn Lane is also called 177th, 9th and 23rd street (hey... it's a Broken Arrow thing)

The MASCUSA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the [MASCUSA] or any official thereof.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST

Welcome to the AKC Temperament Test! There are 198 AKC recognized breeds. One of the things that makes a specific breed unique is not only the dog's physical appearance, but each breed also has its own distinctive temperament.

The AKC Temperament Test (ATT) was developed to bring focus and provide a meaningful evaluation to assess the temperament of our canine companions. Dogs must be 1 year of age to participate and pass 2 separate trials to qualify for a title.

The ATT tests how a dog reacts to a variety of stimuli. Desirable traits are that the dog will be emotionally stable, inquisitive, cooperative, appropriately social for its breed, biddable and demonstrates the ability to recover from a startling situation in a reasonable amount of time.

Undesirable traits are fear, shyness, lack of cooperation and an inability to recover from unfamiliar or unexpected situations. Examples of undesirable behaviors include being afraid of friendly strangers or unfamiliar stimuli, obsessive barking, and aggression.

In the ATT, dogs are tested in 6 categories of stimuli that include:

- 1. Social
- 2. Auditory
- 3. Visual
- 4. Tactile
- 5. Proprioceptive (motion)
- 6. Unexpected stimulus

Notice to Exhibitors

- A separate entry blank must be completed for **each dog entered**. Please use care in clearly indicating which date(s) of entry.
- Dogs must be 1 year of age to participate in the ATT Temperament Test.
- ➤ Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the running order. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.
- Dogs showing any sign of aggression or soiling the ring will be dismissed.
- ➤ Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.
- The MAMASC Treasurer will mail any and all refund checks after the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- ➤ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ➤ Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Test arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.
- > Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, extreme weather conditions, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded in the case of duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing of entries.
- Please bring your own chairs, water for yourself and your dog.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except.
- No telephone, fax, online entries or credit card payments will be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The MAMASC Treasurer will add a \$20.00 collection to the amount of each returned check.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed at the event site.
- No overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. No electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available. RV's are discouraged due to space limitations
- > Crating space may be limited, so please do not bring unentered dogs.
- Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition!
