DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This event is open to all dogs four (4) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club MISC or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. No Champions of Record may compete in an Open Show. Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in Open Shows. Professional handlers are defined according to the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* Chapter 3, Section 7.

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the event grounds.
